The purpose of this transmittal is to provide new and revised guidance for Chapter A, Practice Foundations, of the Virginia Department of Social Services (VDSS) Child and Family Services Manual. Unless otherwise stated, the provisions included in this transmittal are effective upon release.

A new section has been added to the chapter titled **Section 3**. Shared Accountability. The chapter has been reorganized, moving **Section 3**. Guidance Development down to **Section 4**. This will provide a more comprehensive framework for practice foundations.

The content of Section 3. Shared Accountability has been developed in response to legislation the Virginia General Assembly enacted in 2019 related to system reform and improvement. This legislation, Senate Bill 1339, requires VDSS to develop a plan for improving foster care service delivery and outcomes at the local level through enhanced oversight, support and collaboration. Section 3. Shared Accountability, provides policy and procedural guidance for performance measures, meeing this requirement.
