Activity coordinators for special care units can meet requirements in section 22 VAC 40-73-1120 F. 5. of the Standards for Licensed Assisted Living Facilities (40-hours of training in adult group activities/recognizing and assessing activity needs of residents) by completing this 24-hour program, the first 11-hours of "Building Your Skills for Dementia Care: A Person-Centered Approach" offered by the Alzheimer's Assn., and a 5-hour pre-requisite assignment. **The 5-hour pre-requisite assignment is required of all training participants and will be sent to participants upon registration. The assignment must be completed and brought to the first day of training or the participant will not be allowed to attend. There will be no exceptions. \$50 per person for 24-hour activities training and lunch each day. For directions to Markel Building, refer to the attached directions or call: 804-967-2580. Registration is from 8-8:15am each day. The class schedule is very full, please be on time.***
