

Local Training and Development Division (LTD) Support for DARS

The Systems Data and Support Team for LTD will perform the following functions:

- The points of contact who perform training will provide course and event requests via localsupport@dss.virginia.gov.
- The events will be place on the Delivery Spreadsheet for entry.
- The SDAS will enter the event.
- SDAS monitors enrollment and sends a wait list confirmation and close enrollment whenever a course has a waitlist. If the waitlist is resolved, enrollment will be opened again.
- SDAS will send confirmations on the Monday prior to the class and close enrollment.
- If empty seats are available, SDAS will market those seats to anyone need the class from the required training assignments in the VLC.
- Once the class is conducted, the DARS trainer will send the roster for closure to localsupport@dss.virginia.gov. SDAS will close within 24 hours, but usually within the hour.

The SDAS Team will build profiles when requests for new Virginia Learning Center Profiles are requested. The script includes:

Profile Requests of any type including Password Resets

The following information is needed <u>for any profile requests</u>, password resets, activation of existing profiles, etc.

- First Name
- Last Name
- Agency
- Hire Date
- Email Address
- Supervisor
- Job Title with number from the link below
- Did person have existing profile
- Does the learner have any overdue training assignments
- Does this learner assess clients for Assisted Living Facility placement?

- Job Titles as of January 3.pdf (virginia.gov) (Please provide specific job code, only 1)

The profile information is required for profile request of any type including activation, updating job titles or password requests when profiles are inactive, or the agency firewall will not let the information pass.
