ETV assists youth who are currently or were formerly in foster care, with post-secondary education and training expenses.

ETV provides up to \$5,000 per year, per student in grant money to assist with educational and training expenses associated with colleges, universities, and vocational programs.



You are eligible if...

- » Currently in foster care in Virginia or Fostering Futures
- » Age 18 or older when you left foster care
- » Age 16 or older and left foster care through adoption or KinGAP

And...


- you have a high school diploma or GED
- You are enrolled or plan to enroll in an accredited post-secondary program
- » You are 25 years old or younger

- » Tuition and fees
- » Room and board
