



Residents who lived in one of the eligible counties listed below and suffered disaster losses between September 25 and October 24 as a result of Hurricane Helene may be eligible for temporary <u>Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP)</u> benefits.

To qualify, individuals must meet the federal income guidelines and have experienced:

- A loss of food or income, including a reduction or termination of income, or a significant delay in receiving income,
- damage to or destruction of their home or business,
- or additional disaster-related expenses, such as home repairs, temporary shelter, or evacuation costs that are not expected to be reimbursed

Eligible hurricane victims can bring a form of identification and apply for D-SNAP benefits from November 18 – 22 between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. at the following locations:

While current SNAP recipients are not eligible for D-SNAP, SNAP customers in the affected counties who are not already receiving the maximum allotment in SNAP benefits will automatically receive a supplemental benefit on their existing Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card. This benefit will cover the difference between their current monthly allotment and the maximum D-SNAP benefit for their household size - without having to apply at their local agency. If customers do not receive this benefit by November 22, they may contact their LDSS.
